99 YEARS AND COUNTING...

The community benefited from another successful year for the YMCA in 2014 in its **99th** year of existence. Our youth development, healthy living and social responsibility programs continue to strengthen our community. Once again our aquatics departments conducted a very successful Learn to Swim outreach effort that helped hundreds of youth become water safe. Our preschool, after school, and Reach for the Stars programs provided much needed care and programs for over 1,000 youth teaching and modeling the importance of healthy living and physical activity. Sports programs are flourishing with hundreds of youth learning life-changing skills and the importance of teamwork.

YMCA Camp Arbolado was able to provide camperships to deserving boys and girls from the community during the summer and with the sponsorships provided by the Rotary Club of Whittier, 30 youth experienced an unforgettable outdoor camp experience at Rotary Easter Camp.

Over 300 volunteers raised \$370,995 enabling hundreds of youth and families to benefit from the YMCA programs. That along with volunteer time and some other indices, the YMCA provided over \$1.3 million of financial assistance to our community.

The volunteer Endowment Committee, which manages our funds, recorded a 6.07% return on investment for 2014. The Pooled Income fund that allows donors to contribute in \$5,000 increments has grown to \$70,223 with signs of increasing in the near future. The Endowment Fund currently sits at a little over \$6,000,000. Along with good fund management, the YMCA is free from all operating and capital debt.

Since 2008, Activate Whittier has been building a healthy active Whittier through community engagement, and partnerships with a focus on policies to improve the health and wellness of those living, working, learning and playing in our community. Activate Whittier with the YMCA as lead partner and fiscal administrator has been awarded \$700,000 in grant funding and has the support of many community residents and partner organizations. As an integral part of our work the YMCA passed its first wellness policy on April 1, 2015 to ensure a healthier environment for its members, volunteers and staff. Our Y has also signed on to become the healthiest afterschool and early learning program in our service area. By implementing Healthy Eating and Physical Activity (HEPA) standards, all children in the Y have access to healthy food and physical activity.

We are in the Home Stretch regarding the East Whittier YMCA Expansion and Renovation Project! Very soon we will be able to occupy the east side of our renovated YMCA Center. New Landscaping and Walkways will lead to a fresh Lobby, Welcome Center and Community Area. Beautiful Childcare Rooms, Offices, as well as a brand new Healthy Lifestyles Center with all new Cybex Strength and Cardiovascular Equipment!

During our last phase, we will finalize our facility work with new Locker Rooms and Family Changing areas, plus put the finishing touches on our brand new Training Pool and Multi-Purpose room. During this process, we will continue to be open for our members and keep most of our classes and programs running strong! We should be celebrating before the end of 2015 as our entire project should be complete and operational.
