POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the direction of the Camp Executive Director and Program Director and in accordance with Association policies, the Volunteer Camp Counselor is responsible for assisting the Camp Program Director in leading the Camp Arbolado curriculum and activities. The volunteers are also responsible for the safety of all participants and in creating a fun, safe, healthy environment.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Assist in managing youth & adult camp programs.
2. Assist in the supervision of the campers to ensure appropriate development occurs in a fun, healthy and safe environment.
3. Assist with coordinating, guiding, and having fun with the campers.
4. Assist in providing instruction at program activities and daily special events.
5. Ensuring that daily care of the campers is a key priority.
6. Assist in getting the campers up, ready for the day's activities, and getting them down to bed in the evening.
7. Responsible for strict adherence to all policies and procedures related to safety and conduct rules and other regulations.
